

NET CONTROL DIALOGUE for 2 meter net

(5 Minutes before net- 7:55pm:)

This is (your call). The Pamlico Amateur Radio Club's 2 meter net will begin in 5 minutes at 8:00 on this repeater. If you need to make an urgent call, please do so at this time.

(At Net time- 8:00pm:)

Calling the Pamlico Amateur Radio Club 2 meter net, Calling the Pamlico Amateur Radio Club 2 meter net. This is you net control for tonight, (your call), my name is (your name) and my QTH is (your QTH).

This net meets on every Thursday at 8:00pm except for the second Thursday which is club meeting night, on the K4BCH repeater on 147.255 MHz with a PL tone of 131.8. All amateurs are welcome to use this open repeater when a scheduled net is not in session.

This is a directed net and all communication is through the net control station unless otherwise directed. This net is part of the ARRL field organization and its purpose is to provide communications during emergencies and to provide training of "on air procedures" that would apply to actual emergencies and also to test communications capabilities within Beaufort County.

All Radio Amateurs are invited to participate in this net.

We will now begin with check-ins, when checking in give your call sign regularly and then phonetically, followed your name, and then your location and then whether you are with or without traffic. Those who do not want to stay for the informal comments session of the net should ask to be checked "in and out".

First, is here any emergency or priority traffic?

(handle this and then proceed)

Are there any club announcements?

(handle and proceed)

Now, are there any mobile stations wishing to check in?

(Log and acknowledge or if none say)

Hearing none I will now accept check-ins in two groups by the first letter of your call sign suffix.

Any stations with the call sign suffix **Alpha** through **Mike**, please call (your call) now.

(Log and acknowledge until no more call)

Any stations with call sign suffixes **November** through **Zulu**, please call now.

(Log and acknowledge until no more call)

(When all have called)

Let's check for any late check-ins, any station wishing to check-in Alpha through Zulu call (your call)

(Log and acknowledge)

(Finally) Hearing none. This concludes the formal traffic portion of our net; we'll now move to our informal comments session of the net.

(Start with first called-in station and go through the list requesting comments etc.)

(After the list is complete announce)

This is the final call for any late check-ins: any stations, with call sign suffixes throughout the alphabet: Alpha through Zulu, please call (your call) now.

(log and acknowledge)

(Start with first late called-in station and go through the list requesting comments etc.)

(CONCLUSION after all have checked in and talked)

This concludes the Pamlico Amateur Radio Club 2 meter net for this Thursday night. Our thanks to all the operators who checked in tonight. There were (number) check-ins for tonight's net. All stations may secure at their leisure. This is K4GOE returning the repeater to normal amateur use.
